Kansas will share his journey of uncovering the stories that define Sweet Auburn, focusing on how detailed research and compelling narratives bring the neighborhood's history and pivotal role in the Civil Rights Movement to life. This session will offer insights into his methods for blending architectural history with personal stories, emphasizing the importance of preserving both the physical and cultural heritage of this iconic Atlanta district.
